Reviewer Comments

The study "*Risk Factors for Elderly's Hypertension in South Tangerang, Indonesia: A Case Control Study*" is in accordance with the scope of the journal. However, if addressed by the authors, I have some concerns that will make this study a valuable contribution to the body of literature.

- 1- The introduction is well written, with problem identification and justification for the study. However, arguments are not built to support the research objectives, which must be considered to understand the study constructs clearly. Also, many claims throughout the manuscript are not supported by sources/references.
Few instances,
Page 1 *the elderly has a high risk of hypertension due to the increase in systole, even someone whom aged of 65 does not suffer from hypertension still has a risk of hypertension up to 90%*
Page 2 *There are two causes of hypertension, namely irreversible risk factors and modifiable risk factors. Hypertension can occur when there are interactions between two or more risk factors. If there is only one risk factor without being accompanied by other risk factors, then hypertension may not necessarily occur*
I suggest authors should avoid such claims without references.
- 2- The literature review needs to be clearly written and should be the latest. There is a need to add graphs for the geographical area presentation.
- 3- There is a need to elaborate on the research methodology and sample size.
- 4- Findings are presented in detail. It would be good to add the Table for Multivariate Adjusted Odds Ratio for a better understanding of the relationship between contraceptive use and hypertension after controlling for variable family history, eating salty foods, consuming saturated fat, physical activity, stress, and age

- 5- Again, in the discussion, the authors made too many claims without literature support. The authors should divide the discussion into Findings, explaining them based on stated results, literature support, and practical and contextual justifications. Presents the Theoretical and Practical contribution/implications
- 6- The conclusion section also must be added by the authors at the end as a summary of the complete manuscript
- 7- Authors should double-check their citations and match them with the end-text references. Moreover, there is a need to follow the APA 7th edition to record all the references in this study.
