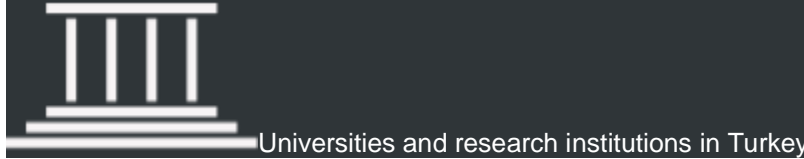

The Effectiveness of Online Learning on Elementary School Student Learning Results

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Abstract

The research entitled the effectiveness of online learning on the learning outcomes of elementary school students, while the purpose of this study was to obtain information about the effectiveness of online learning on student achievement, especially in grades IV and V. This research was conducted at Al Ikhlas Islamic Elementary School. South Jakarta. Indonesia. The method used in this study is a quantitative descriptive approach, the instrument used as an indicator to explore the effectiveness of online learning by using a questionnaire as an instrument. The population this study were students in grades IV A, IV B, V A, VB and VC who were taken randomly, totaling 94 respondents using random sampling. Data analysis used a simple linear regression test with a significant level of 0.05 (5%). Based on the results of the calculation of a significant value of $0.000 < 0.05$, it can be concluded that the effectiveness of online learning on student achievement has a regression equation, this is proven by the results of statistical tests using the T_{test} and the calculation results obtained are $11,064 > 1,661$, with significance level $0.000 < 0.05$. While the effectiveness of online learning on student achievement is obtained a value of 75.6% through the calculation of the coefficient of determination. The results of this study indicate that there is quite a significant or low influence on online learning on student achievement.

Introduction

Learning is about individual activity, learning is an aspect to improve individual Indonesian energy sources in order to produce quality citizen connectors and are able to complete with all countries. In the Government of Indonesia's program to study for 12 years (Law No. 20 Concerning the National Learning System 2003), is a way to produce individuals who connect the nation later, especially now that the Government has distributed free learning facilities up to high school level so that all Indonesians can follow the lesson.

Learning that is easily accepted by students and interesting is one of the most important factors in proving student achievement. The success of professional learning is an explanation of the skills of students resulting from the learning process to achieve educational goals. The learning success can be realized in the form of certificates and indicators, but in several public elementary schools in the village which are classified as still inadequate regarding school facilities and infrastructure, teaching materials are offered in class directly using blackboards and books (Oemar:2001). The position of the teacher remains very prominent, the teacher makes learning programs, and students need to receive lesson plans and information from the teacher. The teacher teaches the material using ordinary media: printed books, Students Worksheet, and whiteboards. Materials that are not supported by teaching media make students bored, hopeless, and passive in the classroom. Successful learning is the acquisition of knowledge about the skills described by the subject, generally seen from the teacher's assessment or evaluation.

Research Methods

The method used in this research is a quantitative approach with a survey method. The aim is to determine the effect of online learning on student achievement at SDI Al-Ikhlās, South Jakarta, Indonesia. The population of this study involved 123 students consisting of 23 students in 4A, 25 in 4B, 23 in 4C, in 5A, and 26 in 5B. The sampling technique in this study is using a simple random sample technique (sample random sampling).

The instrument used in this research is a questionnaire in the form of statements that have been validated. Questionnaire statement items amounted to 48 statements related to the independent variable and the dependent variable. While the data analysis technique uses simple regression analysis to determine the effectiveness of online learning on student learning outcomes, data analysis is used with the help of the SPSS version 22 application.

Literature Review

Online learning, the learning process is moved from school to home, which is a government decision to have a direct impact on learning institutions. Schools carry out a circular from the government to replace the education process which was originally face to face to online education.
